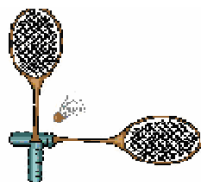
forward to running them. We would be most grateful for any parents coming along to help with this session and of course any other sessions too!

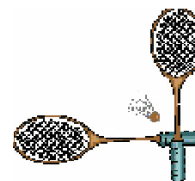
ROLE OF HONOUR

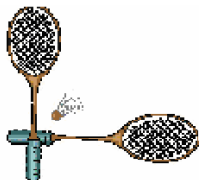

Thank you to the team managers of the Wycombe league **Lynn Payne, Alan Wheeler** and **Myself**.

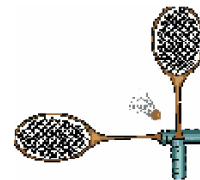
A big thank you to all the Captains in the Aylesbury Junior league **David Chanell, Michael Evett, Joseph Lamb** and **Nancy Payne**.
